Your Travel Process



1 Airline Check-in

- Locate the Allegiant ticket counter
- If you are over 18 years old, check-in with your photo ID
- Check your bags, if needed
- Receive your boarding pass from the Allegiant agent
- Advise the Allegiant agent if you need any extra assistance

2 TSA Screening

- Locate the TSA screening checkpoint and join the line
- Provide your boarding pass and photo ID, if you are over 18, to the TSA officer
- Take off your shoes and jacket and empty your pockets
- Place your belongings in a bin and place the bin on the belt to be screened
- Follow any directions given by the TSA officer
- Once through screening, collect all your belongings and head upstairs

3 Gate Area

- Verify which gate your flight departs from by looking for the gate number on your boarding pass
- Listen for announcements from Allegiant for flight and boarding information
- Visit the food court for a snack or beverage, and/or wait in a seat by your gate
- Do one of the special activities you brought from home

4 Aircraft Boarding

- Locate your group number on your boarding pass
- Listen for boarding announcements from the Allegiant agent
- Once your group number is called, join the line in progress
- Have your boarding pass out for the Allegiant agent to scan
- Once it is scanned, proceed to the jet bridge
- Check your boarding pass for your seat number
- Find your assigned seat number, have a seat and buckle your seat belt
